Experimental Florence - Sesto Fiorentino Science Campus shuttle bus service

Shuttle Bus Florence - Sesto Fiorentino

To improve the connection between Florence and the Scientific Campus of Sesto Fiorentino, the University is providing an experimental shuttle bus service (50 seats) for students, lecturers and technical-administrative staff.

The initiative started on Monday 12 September to coincide with the start of classes.

There will be two outward journeys in the morning and two return journeys to Florence in the afternoon.

Departure in the morning is at 7.35 a.m. from the bus stop in Via Pancaldo (FM0105) at the subway of the Firenze Rifredi railway station (outward journey). The shuttle stops at 7.45 a.m. at the car park in Viale Guidoni, near the T2 tramway, the most important north-west parking area in the city, near the motorway exit and the airport.

At 8 a.m. the shuttle bus arrives at the Sesto Fiorentino science campus, stopping at the stops in Via Sansone, Via Morettini and Via Madonna del Piano.

In the morning there is a second run departing at 8.25 a.m. from Via Pancaldo, stopping at the Guidoni T2 interchange car park at 8.45 a.m. and arriving at the Sesto Fiorentino campus at 9 a.m.

In the afternoon, the shuttle leaves the Sesto Fiorentino university campus at 5.00 p.m. from the stop in Via Madonna del Piano, stopping at the stops in Via Morettini and Via Sansone (return journey).

At 5.25 p.m. it reaches via Pancaldo and at 5.35 p.m. the Guidoni T2 interchange car park.

The second afternoon service makes the same stops as the previous one, departing at 6 p.m. from Madonna del Piano, stopping in Via Pancaldo at 6.25 p.m. and arriving at the Guidoni T2 interchange car park at 6.35 p.m.



The service is free of charge.

Students must show their student card to the driver (freshmen who do not have this card can show their online profile on GCS-Gestione Carriere Studenti).

Technical administrative staff must show their university badge to the driver.

Lecturers are required to have a card to access library services or a certificate issued by their department.

The service may also be used by those who for various reasons work or attend university facilities for study/research purposes (visiting professors, contract lecturers, etc.) in possession of a specific document certifying their service/study relationship with Unifi.

Timetables may be subject to adjustments to further meet the needs of users. Changes will be promptly communicated through Unifi institutional channels.
